Superintendents Report (presented by John Murray/Assistant Superintendent)

- Governing Unaccredited Representatives Defrauding (GUARD) VA Benefits Act vs. Preserving Lawful Utilization of Services (PLUS) for Veterans Act of 2023
 - o GUARD VA Benefits Act is favored by the VACLC
 - GUARD Act Includes criminal punishment for Claim Shark behaviors
 - Potential disbarment for offending attorneys
 - Hundreds of thousands of dollars per year are taken out of the hands of Veterans and their families by unaccredited entities in return for assembling supplemental documentation and filing claims
 - May not charge up front
 - Contract to receive 20-50% of the payouts for the next 12-18 months
 - Andrew Tangen and several other organizations are lobbying on Capitol Hill to make sure elected officials are not misled or swayed by lobbyists donating millions in return for backing the PLUS Act which is opposing legislation
 - Well supported by those looking to "Help Veterans" but only in return for charging a fee from their earned benefits
 - There are many organizations in addition to National Association of County Veterans Service Officers (NACVSO) that do not charge fees
 - We, as an organization, feel it is offensive to charge
 - o Please feel free to refer to the VFW Claim Shark flyer found on all tables
 - o If anything comes up in your Post, please support the GUARD Act
 - o Andrew is in Washington lobbying for the Guard Act today
 - Second trip to Washington this year after NACVSO conference

- Special Use Permit Update (SUP)
 - A tax exemption for us as a government entity
 - Locations currently zoned for commercial use only
 - o Andrew, John, and our attorney met with the Gurnee Planning and Zoning Board (PZB)
 - Presented their vision and timeline for the new building
 - Answered 5 questions
 - Approved unanimously by PZB
 - o Meeting is scheduled on November 22, 2023 for the Village Board final approval
 - Closing Outback property on November 26, 2023
 - o Closing on the Crab Shack property on November 28, 2023
 - County Finance is aware of those dates and our intentions to finalize
 - Funds will be released and we will be the proud owners of both lots
 - No rent fees in new building
 - First time in organizational history
 - Have been paying rent since 1926
- New Hire Update
 - 6 new positions
 - 4 Veteran Service Officer (VSO) positions, 1 Administrative Assistant, 1 Paralegal
 - Posting positions first week of December
 - End of January narrowing of list to 20
 - First interview to get down to 5
 - Second interview to select candidates
 - Post members are encouraged to refer candidates with similar values to apply
 - Veterans first
 - Certified VSOs first so training will be minimized
 - Apply on Lake County website
 - Background check, VAC training, VA training, NACVSO accreditation
 - Will be outside hires no internal applications
 - Round of applause for current staff efforts
